

Rubric for Dubai – Draft

We are looking for students who are well rounded in production and media. Students should submit the following via a wiki page on the Westwood Wiki at <http://westwood.wikispaces.com> – the Dubai links will be on the homepage. You can link to anything you create from that page.

Items to Include:

1. Parental / Guardian Consent - REQUIRED

- Parental consent from both parents attached. (Without this, you will be disqualified.)

2. Artistic Ability – 30 points

We have five types of skills we're looking for:

1. Blogging and Writing ability
2. Video interviewing ability
3. Filmmaking to tell a story
4. Artistic creation of any kind
5. Podcast interview ability

After reviewing what you can find online about the conference, please post previous work (up to 4 artifacts) on the wiki for review. Under each artifact, type how you would use this at the conference.

3. Example Creation – 20 points

Watch this panel discussion from the 2014 Global Education and Skills Conference (<http://j.mp/gec-sample>) . Create a sample artifact from one (or more) of the 5 categories above that demonstrate how you would have covered this panel discussion.

It should be the kind of thing that you would write if you were there in Dubai with hyperlinks, etc.

4. Why Do You Want to Go? – 20 points

Why do you want to go to Dubai? In 500 words or less write for us why you want to go to cover the Global Education and Skills Conference in Dubai.

5. 1. Teacher Feedback / possible Interviews – 30 points

We will solicit feedback from teachers of students to find out. In the case of a tie, we may have outside people interview students?

- How well does the student make up work when they are out?
- How well does the student follow dress code? (Middle eastern customs require a strict dress code in order not to offend people.)
- How well does this student follow instructions?
- What is the responsibility level of this student?
- Does this student produce work within a timed format?
- Other factors that need consideration.
